Dear Citizens,

This flyer provides you with important information about the key measures to take in the event of major emergencies, such as extreme weather, forest fires, flooding, or prolonged power outages. These scenarios can affect us at any time! Your safety and property may be at risk!

Although crises often occur unexpectedly, the district and municipalities are well prepared. You should be prepared too!

Personal Preparedness

Familiarize yourself with potential emergencies. Think about your personal emergency plan (e.g., stock up on supplies for at least ten days, prepare a document folder, and secure your home against natural hazards).

Warning and Information for the Public

The following means of warning and information are used to inform the public: radio, the NINA warning app, cell broadcast, sirens, social media, websites, and loudspeaker vehicles.

KIEZ Crisis, Information, and First Aid Center

The Märkischer Kreis, together with its member towns and municipalities, has launched the KIEZ project.

A bulky term with a simple message:

This is where you can get help when nothing else works!

In the event of major damage incidents and/or a hazardous situation, significant disruptions to daily life are to be expected. That's why KIEZ locations are set up as contact points. There, you will receive support tailored to the specific needs of the situation.

You may have heard of similar concepts from other regions under names such as "Emergency Information Points (NIPs)" or "Disaster Relief Beacons."

Depending on the severity of the damage, there are two KIEZ levels:

KIEZ Level 1 serves as an emergency information point

Here, you will receive information about the danger situation, extended first aid, and the ability to make an emergency call.

KIEZ Level 2 is intended for emergency care

In addition to the services provided by KIEZ Level 1, you will also have the opportunity to temporarily find shelter if you need to leave your home due to a hazardous situation.

You can easily recognize the KIEZ locations by the signs shown below. These signs are prominently displayed at the locations.

Information about the activation of the locations will be provided through our channels (see the back).


