# **VACCINATION PROTECT LIVES!**



- Vaccination protects against COVID-19, the disease triggered by the CORONA virus.
- All authorised vaccines have a high medical effectiveness. Especially against severe courses of the disease.
- The vaccines are safe as they have been tested well. They are being checked further continually.
- There are different vaccines. The vaccines do not change the DNA – as sometimes asserted.
- For full protection you need two vaccination appointments. With the “Johnson & Johnson” vaccine only one dose is necessary.
- The most frequent side effects may be pain, skin reddening or swellings at the injection site, tiredness, headache or a temperature.
- Once many people have been vaccinated, a lot of restrictions of public life will fall. Before that, however, a large part of the population will have to be immune.
- If you have already had CORONA, you should wait another six months with your vaccination. Having overcome the disease means you are safe for the time being.
- Vaccination is completely voluntary and there is no check whether you get yourself vaccinated or not. Your legal residence status is not affected by vaccination.
- You may get your vaccination at the Borough Vaccination Centre or by your family doctor.

- Information about who is currently entitled to be vaccinated is provided on the website of the Borough and on Facebook.
- Even after vaccination: Still go on wearing a mask and obey the rules.
